Apply in sufficient water to ensure good coverage; use a minimum of 5 gals/A when applied by air and a minimum of 10 Gals/A when applied by ground.</p> <p>To provide optimum coverage and penetration, add a penetrating type spray adjuvant at the manufacturer's specified rate.</p> <p>Do not apply more than 3.25 oz./A per application. Do not exceed a total of 11.0 oz./A per crop per season. Allow a minimum of 7 days between applications. Allow a minimum of 14 days (PHI) between the last application and harvest.</p> <p>(1) Aphid pests listed in the individual crop sections are the species that most commonly infest that crop. However, Fulfill Insecticide will control aphid species in the Product Information Section of the federal label. (2) Suppression Only</p>
